Thank you for your query which was referred to daa by the Minister for Transport. For decades, Dublin Airport has been a supporter of community activities, promoting development in education, literacy, sports and the arts. The Dublin Airport Community Fund supports local projects that make a difference to our neighbouring communities. We recently doubled our community spend to €400,000 per year for 25 years, making €10m available in total.

Under the fund, we have also partnered with the Dublin City University Access Service to provide scholarships to those students that may be marginalised in our community, giving them a unique opportunity to access third level education.
